- 2. Matters arising from previous minutes not otherwise covered on the agenda: None.

3. Report from the Chair

Angela will submit town hall update separately but we have had an offer of help from Civic Voice.

Congratulations to Ian Stuart and his team for being the best railway station in Cheshire. There will be a new manager at the Interchange and it is hoped there can be a welcome and celebrations.

TMBC are about to go into purdah and as was with the Queen's death some of the cancellations don't make a lot of sense. Altrincham town centre is beginning to fade and will probably get worse but nothing can be done till after the elections although originally it could be.

Trafford Housing Trust are content for Citibranch to work with us on New Street.

We have met with Trafford College's new lead and a second meeting is planned, with Angela's jury service getting in the way. In the meantime we are meeting with Victoria Williams who is on a contract to seek out volunteers. I am also meeting with the Chair of Sale Civic Society next week.

The Methodist Church Organisation are having a consultation about which local churches to close. Looks like Altrincham may go which will be a huge site within the neighbourhood plan area.

Work on the Local Listing continues apace and a meeting is planned with Lis Lewis and Mark Watson from the Victoria Society to discuss the Town Hall's heritage.

Good news that Kirsten is returning to Dunham Massey so we can resume work with The National Trust.

Chair reported that she had met with the Chair of Sale Civic Society earlier today and he says some items relating to town hall are stored at a disused primary school in Partington. She has asked Cllr Michael Welton to arrange for us to venture there to see what there is. Local Studies are doing an inventory of what is actually in the town hall now and she understands George Cogshill is very concerned about the future of the war memorials. The Victoria Society are coming down to the town hall next week as part of a Local Listing project.

5. Altrincham Town and Business Update.

Gails Bakery is taking the former Mustard unit & is planned to open 26th March.

One Central is now closed and the area is planned for re-development, which includes H&B & what was Milletts.

Unagi are going into the unit next to The Bricklayers

The former Bottle Shop is to become Papa Dutch, a pancake house with a licence and they're to sell Dutch beers. They have been trading on Altrincham Market

No progress on King Pong or Wild Goose to report

The Orange Tree closed a week or so ago due to poor trade and the Bricklayers is closed due to building faults

Work on the former Bistrot Pierre seems to be underway

Hex bar opened & closed withing a few days, they've now moved to Macclesfield but I do have someone interested in the unit as a children's cafe again.

Paperchase will be closing shortly.

Bayse Fitness opened in the former Ladbrokes unit

A shock closure was Kingfisher Chippy

The Massage Company are due to open in what was KFC on Lloyd St

Snugworld Bsd shop is shortly to become Bar Etna

Harcourt opened in what was Stamford Bistro on Stamford New Road

Hospitality

Trevor and I attended the Best Bar None Awards night at the House of Lords with Sir Graham Brady. We did have nominations in for awards but were up against much bigger schemes in Plymouth, Nottingham and Sheffield. Maybe next year there will be a small scheme award & we might stand a chance. We did meet Lord Smith of Hindhead and we have a lovely picture to remember the evening.

We both participated in the conference in the afternoon and it appears we are doing more than some schemes. I'm constantly on the look for new ideas to introduce to our hospitality.

We're one of few independent schemes, most are run by BIDs or Councils which was interesting to learn.

Heather, the Manager at The Unicorn has left us as she's due to have a baby soon, she has been a huge support to the bar committee.

Other news

Paint Altrincham Pink finished on Sunday. Prevent Breast Cancer are still to confirm totals and we need to round up donations from the bars and retailers.

Sarah Leary (Juice) and I are now Ambassadors so we helped the 2 weeks.

The "Pubcrawl" didn't go as well as in previous years but Pink the Rink did really well.

The BID fashion show was well attended and raised a lot of money. BID also organised a "Flamingo in the window" trail which was a fun addition. Kitson Architects and Albex, though not part of the "official flamingo event" did join in.

Judie and I have been talking to Councillors and Council Officers about bringing back a version of Altrincham Forward, currently named "AF2" following our AGM when Matt Colledge pointed out that a community that comes together is the most successful.

We have had dialogue with Richard Roe & Cllr Michael Welton. Adrian Fisher at Trafford Council has been tasked with helping us, Mike Shields who was part of the original AF is interested in helping us. Currently the initial group is AaBCS, Altrincham Partnership, the NBP and the bar groups. We have yet to agree with Trafford College but Judie and I did have a productive meeting a week or so ago & Joan is back on the scene who was also an "AF original".

We're thinking start with a blank piece of paper and start again.

Trevor and I have been out and we think there are about 20% vacant units and this is set to increase from conversations I've had with businesses

Laura Sharrock has been appointed as the new Chair of BID. Laura is a Solicotor at McHale and owner of Skanda. We look forward to working with her.

Loretto Prep school is closing in the summer.

6. Altrincham Town Hall

Angela reported that at the last Trafford B.C. executive meeting, it was decided to go with a full tender process for the lease. Submissions have to be made by August.

Angela also reported that she intends to apply for a grant from the Government for a start up Community Ownership Fund, although we would establish a separate Community Interest Company (CIC) to initially receive this money if successful.

7. Planning

Paulina reported that the owners of the Southmark Building had applied to add an extra storey and a roof terrace. She expressed concern that this would tend to make the building tower over the immediately adjacent buildings.

7. Broadheath update from Leslie Cupitt

Lidl had added some additional doors to their plans for their new store next to Homebase. The council advised that should apply for planning consent after the current works are completed.

Progress is being made on the formation of a Friends of Woodstock Park Group with a meeting of interested parties to take place shortly.

It was agreed that the Broadheath Partnership Meeting minutes will be shared with the Civic Society.

Chair reported that the Best Kept Station Awards Event last week went well, although it was regretted that the Mayor of Trafford did not attend the event. Altrincham Interchange was among the winners.
